

Code of Conduct for Board Members
Wildrose Loyalty Coalition (WLC)

A. PURPOSE

- a. The purpose of the code of conduct is to ensure that all signatories are aware of the parties expectations, as listed in the bylaws, with regards to behaviour towards the party and its members.

B. APPLICANTS

- a. This form is to be completed by all board members, at the Constituent Association(CA) level as well as Provincial Board, and all volunteers.
- b. The form may be filled electronically or on a printed document, and is to be saved by the respective CA, and Provincial VP of Membership.

C. CONDUCT EXPECTATIONS

- a. WLC holds all its members to a high standard. Your signature below demonstrates your recognition that as a member and volunteer you are not only responsible to the party, but also a representative of the party.
- b. All volunteers have the right to be respected and to work in a safe and respected environment, free of discrimination, harassment, and violence.
- c. By accepting a volunteer position, you are recognizing your fiduciary duty to the party. You agree to act with integrity and in the interest of WLC.
- d. Volunteers must bring into awareness any potential conflict of interests. The nature of the reported conflict must be entered into the minutes.
- e. All volunteers and members will follow the party bylaws and other ruling documents from Elections Alberta and WLC including, but not limited to, Constituency Association and Candidate Nomination Rules.
- f. All intellectual, and or/other trademarks ownership will be retained by the WLC Party.

D. BREACH OF CODE

- a. Any breaches of the Code of Conduct will be subject to consequences as outlined in the party bylaws, and enforced by the Party Arbitration Committee.

- b. It will be considered a breach of code, for confidentiality to not be maintained, unless deemed necessary by the party arbitration committee.
- c. A believed breach of conduct is to be reported directly to the Party Arbitration Committee Chair, unless there is a conflict of interest, in which case it can be reported to the party VP of Membership or VP of Bylaws and Governance.
